

Safety Tip #1 – Maintain Good Housekeeping

- Work area, corridors, escapes ways and staircases should be kept clear at all times.
- Never obstruct fire emergency exits and fire call points with fire fighting equipment.
- Avoid build up of combustible trash and waste.
- Keep minimum storage of combustibles materials.
- Clean up oil spills or grease after usage.



Safety Tip #2 - Spot and remove Electrical Fire Hazards

- Don't overload electrical points



- Remove electrical devices without safety mark



Safety Tip #3 - Spot and intervene unsafe practices or behaviours

- Over-heating of machinery
- Improper storage of flammable substances
- Hot works carried out at unsafe areas
- Smoking at unauthorised areas and careless throwing of lighted cigarette butts
- Obstructed fire exits and passage ways
- Spilled chemicals not attended to
- Poor or Non-maintenance of fire fighting provisions
